

**RESOLUTION NO. 15-72**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE WASECA CITY COUNCIL  
SETTING WATER RATES**

**WHEREAS**, the Waseca City Council establishes water rates by resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, water rates have been reviewed in light of the budgetary needs for the water utility; and

**WHEREAS**, the need to address existing capital infrastructure replacement will require additional revenue for the water utility; and


**WHEREAS**, the water utility funding needs will not be met without an increase in rates; and

**WHEREAS**, an equitable distribution of the increasing funding needs can be made by increasing the charges as set forth in the Attachment.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Waseca that the water rates shall be amended as set forth in the Attachment which is hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

This resolution shall become effective upon its passage without publication.

- c. All meters must be obtained from the water utility.
- d. Meter replacement charges will apply based on the current meter prices.
- e. Unique Accounts capital funding charges will be determined by staff based on past practice.
