### **City Wide Brush Pick Up**

Attached is the Spring 2017 Waseca Lakes Assn Newsletter. Some recent items that did not make the newsletter are:

1. We received our permit from the DNR to treat 21.7 acres of curly leaf pondweed in Clear lake, that will likely be done next week, so if you see some markers along the shorelines, they are for indicating treatment areas. See permit map attached.
2. We have set a meeting date of 7pm on Tuesday, May 9th (likely at the county East Annex) for a discussion on the recent MSU Water Study (attached) that addresses a long term management approach to improving the water quality in Loon and Clear Lakes. A long term management plan has been discussed and researched for 10 years now, so we are eager to finally get to this point. Please attend if possible and stay tuned for details.
