Ongoing Utility Construction

Electric utility construction projects are occurring in the following areas:

1. Convert overhead to underground conductors on Second Street NW, south of Sixth Ave. Property owners and renters have received construction letters.
2. Noetzel Addition, north of Clear Lake Park. Property owners and renters have received construction letters.
3. Three phase underground conductors replacement through the City owned Clear Lake Marsh.

Updates will be posted as construction continues throughout the season.
