Waseca Water Park Now Open!

The Water Park opened on Friday, June 2 and had a successful opening weekend! Concessions ran out late Sunday and a special order had to be made to keep up with the high traffic. Maximum capacity was hit both Friday and Saturday. We are expecting to have another stellar weekend with the high forecasted temperatures.

Environmental Quality Board Meeting (Climate Impacts in Waseca, MN)

The Environmental Quality Board will hold their June 14 board meeting in Waseca, Minnesota. Waseca was hit with 10.16 inches of rain in a 48-hour time period in September 2016. The rainfall resulted in extensive flooding, damaging 75% of Waseca homes and businesses. This meeting is scheduled to explore the climate impacts to Waseca, the region, and the state in general. Old TH HWY 14/Elm Ave Construction Update

The reconstruction of Old TH 14 / Elm Avenue is being initiated. The Contractor (Ulland Brothers Inc.) plans to initiate construction beginning on June 12, 2017. Please be advised of the following information / road closures as it may impact Emergency Services.

Road closures starting June 12, 2017 in the City of Waseca (Local Traffic Only)

- Ulland Brothers will begin roadway milling and removals on June 12, 2017, Utility construction is expected to begin the week of June 19, 2017
 - Location: Old TH 14 (CSAH 2 – Brown Avenue to Lake Street / Experimental Station Road) and (9th Street SE to between 11th and 13th Street SE)
 - Old TH 14 Detour of the City of Waseca will go into effect beginning on June 12, 2017 around 10:30 AM.
 - Additional updates will be forthcoming as construction progresses.
- Old TH 14 Tree Removal – Periodic Road closures due to tree removal from CSAH 2 – Brown Avenue to Clear Lake Drive. This work will begin on June 14 and extend to June 16. – Contractor will provide traffic control and flaggers. Short duration delays (less than 10 minutes expected).

Environmental Quality Board Meeting (Climate Impacts in Waseca, MN)

St. Paul, MN: The Environmental Quality Board will hold their June 14 board meeting in Waseca, Minnesota. Waseca was hit with 10.16 inches of rain in a 48-hour time period in September 2016. The rainfall resulted in extensive flooding, damaging 75% of Waseca homes and businesses. This meeting is scheduled to explore the climate impacts to Waseca, the region, and the state in general.

The agenda includes discussions from the State Climatology Office, city staff, County and State Emergency Management staff, the Region 9 Development Commission, and state climate adaptation staff. Questions to be addressed include: What are the climate trends in the region? How did the rain and flooding affect the community's operations, residents, and businesses? How did the community respond and what were the resources available? How is the community responding with long term planning efforts? Is the state doing anything to help prevent this from happening in other communities or provide the resources needed when it does? A public comment period will follow presentations.
